## More fundraisers planned for Burke family

Jan. 27, 2011 - Prior to Madeline and Mary Burke moving to Houston to prepare for 15-year-old Madeline's lung transplant, an account was set up with Children's Organ Transplant Association to handle donations being made to the family. Donations go into this fund and are disbursed to the family as needed, and are not considered taxable income for the family. A local account was set up at American Bank of Texas for the convenience of local persons or organizations wishing to donate to the COTA fund in honor of Madeline Burke.

People in Leonard responded very quickly in the fall of 2010, organizing garage sales, bake sales, raffles, golf tournament, dance, and restaurant proceed donations. One anonymous donor gave \$500 with the stipulation that the amount be matched, whichwas achieved through the dance fundraiser organized by Clayton Kemp. Several businesses also have coin containers setup to collect donations, and all of these fundraising efforts have brought in \$25,000 of the \$40,000 projected to be needed by the family. But, more fundraisers are needed for the remainder of the money. Following is a list of upcoming events where proceeds will be donated to COTA in honor of Madeline Burke.
